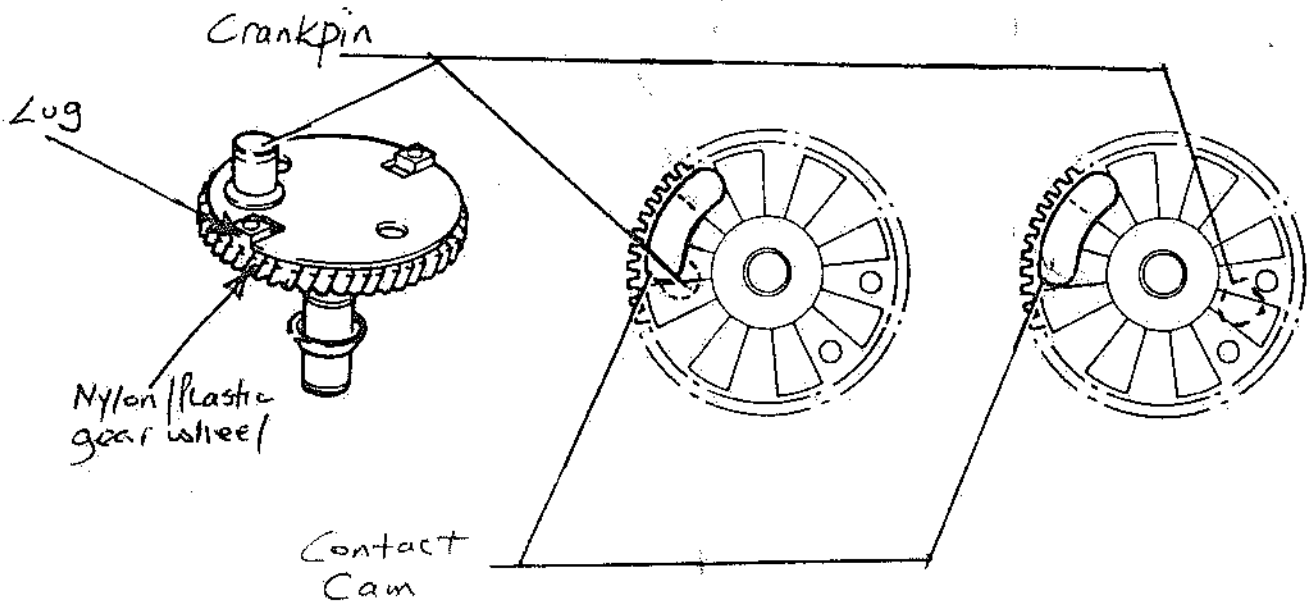

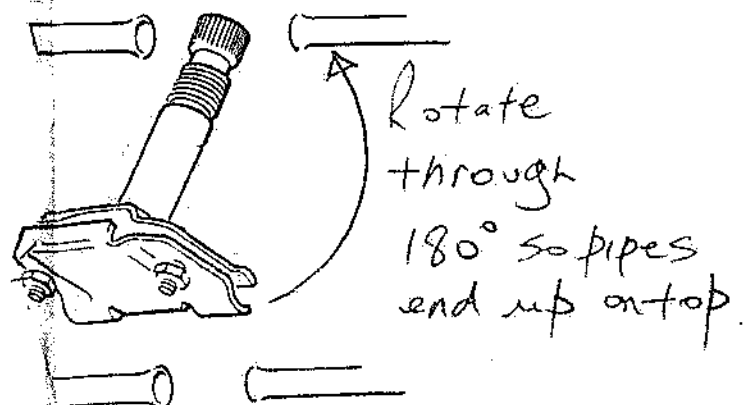

WINDSCREEN WIPER Parking Position

I've noticed on a couple of Hustlers that the windscreen wiper is parked on the drivers side of the screen. I don't know if this is desired, but if not there is a simple way of changing the park position so that the wiper will park on the nearside of the screen. All that has to be done is to separate the nylon/plastic gear wheel from the spindle (it's just a push fit) and rotate it through 180°. Then re-join them by pushing them together so that the spindle flange locates with the lugs on the gear wheel. See diagram below:-

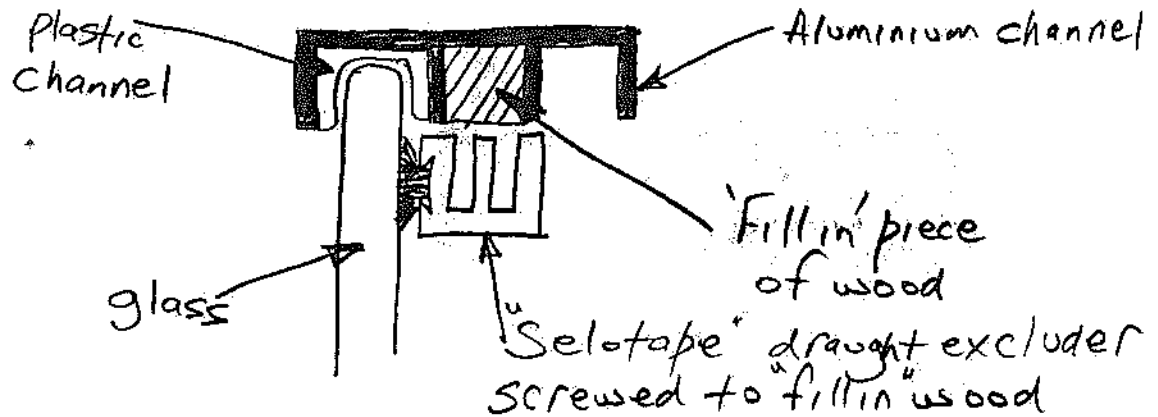


Alternatively the windscreen wiper box can be rotated through 180°. See diagram below:-



Rattling Windows!!

I've come across a way of cutting down the rattling but as yet have not completely eliminated it. The company 'Selotape' market a draft excluding kit consisting of 6 strips of plastic moulding with a nylon 'brush' arrangement located in a channel down one side. This I have fitted to the top and angled pieces of channelling of the aluminum. See diagram below :-

In reply to Martin Guinan's comment in the last N/L —Yes I thought a wooden 6 would be under powered and it is certainly alot cheaper to build. On initial costing against a metal and fibre glass 6 it worked out to be approx £600 cheaper at the time, plus the fact it is easier to do modifications when you have control over cutting out the shapes from the wood. I'm looking forward to seeing how someone else has modify a wooden 6 to accomodate a larger engine.

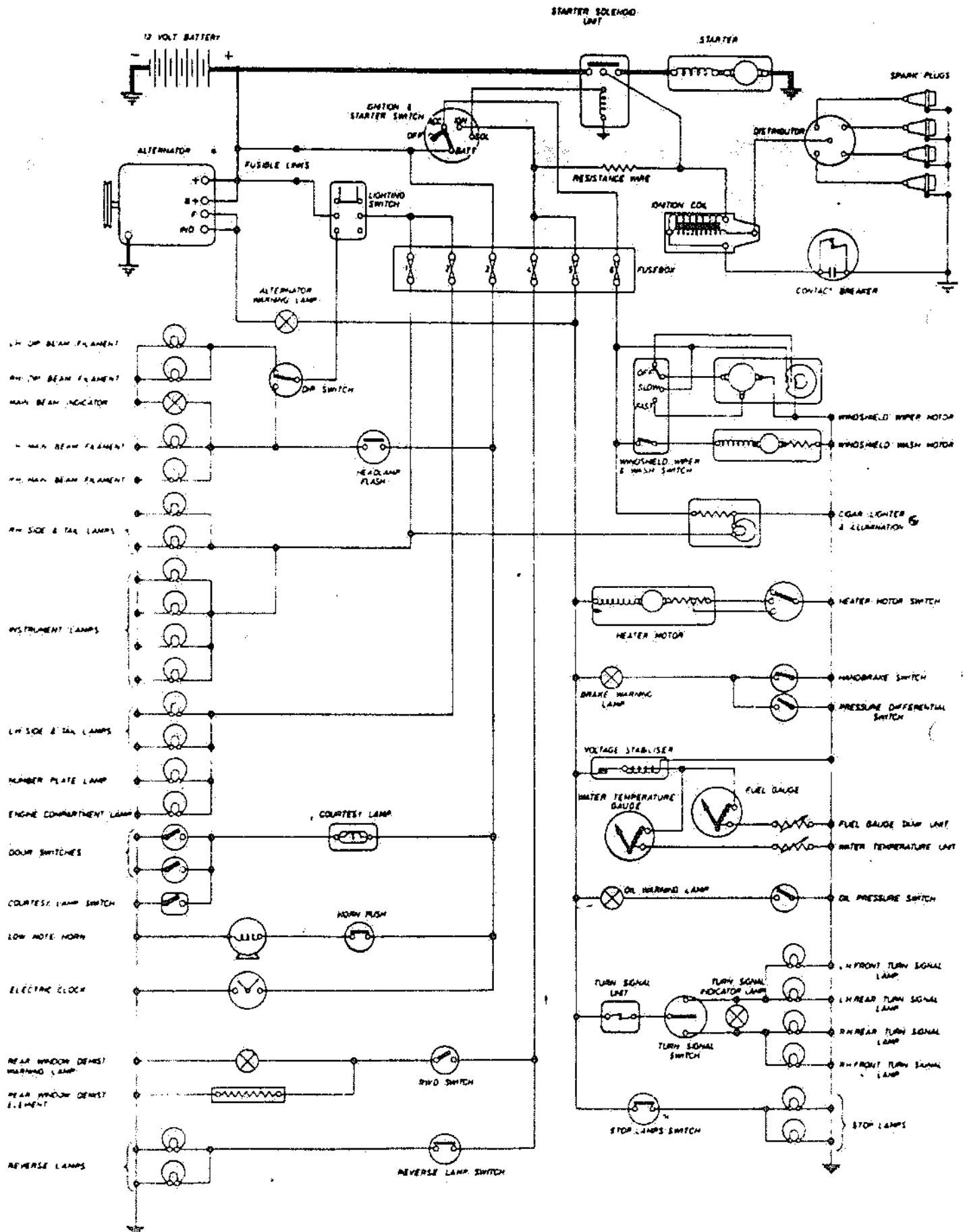

I havent included a list of cars for sale as it seems rather pointless. Most members have either got cars or are in the middle of building one.

Instead I keep a description of the cars for sale by the phone for when I get any enquiries. By the way why not bring the car to Stonleigh and put a 'for sale' notice on it on the club pitch.

I noticed the magazine article regarding the rubber timing 'chain' and I can certainly vouch for it. I did mention it when I wrote to you before - it is very easy to fit and twelve months/6 months later has caused no problems at all. If anyone is changing their timing chain it is worth doing.

The article by Keith Sharp was most interesting, there is no substitute for c.c.'s no matter what you do to the engine. You may recall that I modified my 1000cc engine to extract the last drop of power out of it but it does still lack power at lower engine revs. I did get it properly tuned on a rolling road and the engine now develops 58bhp at the wheels which is not at all bad but unfortunately its at 5,800 rpm. Not too much use in top gear as it works out at 90+mph, but it can be used to the full in lower gears where the effect as it comes 'on cam' is quite dramatic. In case anyone is interested and does not want to go to the trouble of major modifications to fit a larger engine I did the following:-

- Stage 2 head (large inlet valves)
- water heated inlet with 1½ carb.
- Cooper exhaust
- modified 731 camshaft

This does have the advantage of overall low cost comparatively but does not produce a great deal of power below 2500rpm.

The only real answer is a bigger engine. The engine tuner at Marshalls of Cambridge has been quite impressed with Avonbar's products, their 1400cc produces plenty of power at all revs. In fact it should compare well with the 1750cc but you can, I understand, get poor conversions from some suppliers.

Incidentally, my modified 1000cc managed to come back from the last Hustler at Home at 60mph+ or 70 on dual carriageway and managed to average 34mpg!

Having now passed its second MOT without much difficulty the MOT tester did make the remark that Mini steering racks are notorious for wear if fitted with wider wheels. My rack will need replacing in the next 12 months so if anyone is in the process of building it could well be worth putting in an exchange rack from the start.
